The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 29 dated 02.02.2020 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Dhakoli, District SAS Nagar, Punjab.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 2 has submitted that although, the petitioner has paid the money but as per his instructions, respondent No. 2 has not given any consent with respect to the quashing of the present FIR.
