This is a revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 23.11.2021 (Anneuxre P-1) vide which the application of the petitioner for recalling the respondent for further cross-examination has been dismissed by the trial Court.

A bare perusal of the impugned order shows that the petitioner had got enough opportunities to cross-examine the witness, whom he wants to cross-examine now and qua which the prayer has been rejected by the Court below. The record shows that the witness Hukam Chand was cross-examined by the present petitioner on three different dates in continuation. Therefore, by any means, it cannot be said that the petitioner has not been granted effective opportunity to cross-examine the said witness. Although, the counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had changed the counsel, who wants to bring on record certain documents, however, mere change of counsel is no ground in itself to grant any further opportunity to cross-examine a witness, which already stands cross-examined at length for several dates in continuation.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
