1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 16.09.2019, in CWP-19337-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-19337-2019, filed by certain candidates, who had applied in response to advertisement issued by the Haryana State Teachers Selection Board, for recruitment to 300 posts of Primary Teachers was allowed vide order dated 16.09.2019, and the respondents were directed to give benefits to said candidates in terms of order Annexure R/1, as also to other affected candidates who had not approached the Court.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the notice issued in the instant case, learned DAG, Haryana has furnished order dated 20.05.2022, releasing benefits to the petitioners, as per their entitlement, therefore the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to

withdraw the same.

4. Order dated 20.05.2022, produced by the learned DAG, Haryana, is taken on record.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
