This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and restraining the private respondents, who are his wife and in-laws, from pressurizing the petitioner to withdraw FIR No. 133 dated 16.11.2019, registered at Police Station City Rampura.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in above-said FIR No.133 dated 16.11.2019, the cancellation report has been submitted and in fact, an FIR No.7 dated 09.01.2020 has been registered against the present petitioner under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC.

Learned State counsel has further pointed out that in the present petition, notice of motion was issued on 13.01.2020 and the fact that the petitioner is involved in a criminal case was not disclosed.

In view of the fact that a material point with respect to the petitioner being an accused in FIR No.7 dated 09.01.2020 had not been disclosed in the present petition and no challenge has been made to the said FIR, it is apparent that the present petition seeking protection is absolutely misconceived and is merit less and thus, deserves to be dismissed and is accordingly dismissed.
