[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 22.10.2009 in RSA No.1901 of 2009 in case titled as Iqbal Singh and another vs. Charanjit Singh and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that while admitting RSA No.1901 of 2009 on 22.10.2009, status quo with regard to possession was ordered to be maintained.

[3] Today, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners states that an amicable settlement has been arrived at between the parties, viz-a-viz compliance with the orders of this Court as referred to above and that in the circumstances possession of the property has been returned to the petitioners, therefore, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
