After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, while submitting that the petitioner would be surrendering before the trial Court within one week positively and would be moving an appropriate application for seeking the relief of regular bail there and he prays that the concerned Court be directed to decide the said bail application of the petitioner within some specific time frame.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn.
