Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.247 dated 06.12.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 307, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 13.01.2022: -

“...As per the case of the prosecution, the first informant who was working at a relevant time in a shop was beaten up by various persons including the petitioner herein. It has been alleged that the petitioner caused injuries to the first informant with the reverse side of 'datar' on the right wrist of the first informant.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that there is a cross-version and the injury in question has been

declared to have been caused with a blunt weapon and not with a deadly weapon like a 'datar'!...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagga Ram, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the order dated 13.01.2022 passed by this Court, vide which interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
