By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.31, dated 15.02.2018, having been registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 307/506/148/149 of the IPC.

Pursuant to the order dated 21.01.2022, learned State counsel submits that, as per his instructions from SI Karamjit, the petitioner has joined investigation and it being a case of no injury, his custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed, with the order dated 21.01.2022, made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he would be always at liberty to avail of his remedy as per law.
