This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in the context of FIR No. 200, dated 25.11.2020, registered at Police Station City-2, Police District Khanna, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 323/324/379-B/506/148/149 of the IPC.

This in fact is the 2nd petition filed by the petitioner with the same prayer made, the first one having been withdrawn on 15.12.2021, on a statement to that effect having been made by the petitioners' mother and with an affidavit of the petitioner to that effect also having been submitted to this court in that petition (CRM-M-44511-2021).

As regards the present petition, learned counsel for the State has filed in court today a short reply thereto, stating therein that other than the FIR in question, there are three other FIRs registered against the petitioner,

02 under the provisions of Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, and one under the provisions of Section 52-A of the Prisons Act, 1894.

Learned State counsel submits that in fact the FIR registered under the provisions of the Prisons Act is on account of a mobile phone having been recovered from the petitioner and with learned counsel appearing for the complainant submitting that the petitioner is still threatening the complainant by even 'Whatsapp' messages, from the jail itself.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner may be allowed to withdraw this petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
