The prayer in this application under Order XXIII Rule 1 read with Section 151 CPC is for withdrawal of the writ petition.

It is submitted that leave encashment was withheld by the department on account of disciplinary action contemplated against the applicant-petitioner. During the pendency of the writ petition, the inquiry has been completed and nothing incriminating was found against the petitioner. 'No Objection Certificate' is stated to have been issued by the contesting respondent i.e. The Punjab State Federation of Co-operative House Building Societies Ltd. (respondent No.3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the above positive development during the pendency of the writ petition, the effect of the impugned order withholding leave encashment has come to an end and as such seeks to withdraw the writ petition.

The present application has been filed through the original counsel.

Notice of the application.

Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2.

Office report shows that reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 is already on record and respondent Nos.3 and 4 were duly served. There has been no representation on behalf of respondent Nos.3 and 4.

Accordingly, the application is allowed. The main case is preponed from 07.12.2022 and with the consent of the parties, the same is taken on Board today itself.
