This is a petition that has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.291 dated 06.08.2021 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

Counsel for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the said matter. It is argued that the only allegation against the petitioner is that he was found to have provided bank account of one Pankaj to Akhlesh for depositing Rs.50,000/- out of the cheated amount and he is in receipt of 5% of the said amount. It is submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 18.10.2021. It is further submitted that that matter has been investigated and challan stands presented, therefore, prays for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State would oppose grant of regular bail to the petitioner by contending that the allegations levelled

against the petitioner are serious in nature, however, he does not dispute the fact that the matter has been investigated and challan stands presented.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and deem it appropriate to allow regular bail to the petitioner considering the fact that the main dispute, as per the FIR, would be of cheating done by the BSP Enterprises.

Accordingly, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his adequate execution of personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned trial court/Duty Magistrate.

However, any observation made herein shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on merits of the case.
