1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 16.01.2014, in CWP-9823-2007.

2. At the outset, learned counsel contends that LPA No.330 of 2014, challenging the order in CWP-9823-2007, dated 16.01.2014, was dismissed by Hon'ble the Division Bench. Learned counsel contends that in view of Civil Appeal No.6636 of 2018, having been disposed of by Hon'ble the Supreme Court by setting aside order dated 11.08.2004, passed by the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, as well as order dated 26.02.2014, passed in LPA No.330 of 2014 and the matter remanded for fresh consideration before the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to pursue the matter before the learned State Transport Commissioner, Punjab.

3. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not

calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner to pursue the matter before the learned State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, in accordance with law.
