[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 02.04.2013 in CRWP No.103 of 2013 as well as subsequent order, Annexure P/2 dated 30.10.2014 in CRM-W-139 of 2014 in CRWP No.103 of 2013 as also subsequent order, Annexure P/3 dated 22.04.2015 in TA No.668 of 2012.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the aforementioned orders having resulted in compliance by virtue of orders passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court granting custody of the petitioner's daughter to the petitioner, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
