The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents No.1 and 2 to initiate an appropriate disciplinary action against the delinquent police officials.

A Status report by way of affidavit of Parmdeep Singh, Under Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs & Justice has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. A copy thereof has been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner. It has been specifically averred in the aforesaid status report that the competent authority has already taken a decision of imposing cut in the pension of delinquent officers Ram Parkash, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police (retired). It is further submitted that the proceedings qua Surinder Singh, Sub Inspector had to be abated on account of his death on 09.08.2022. Further, a penalty of stoppage of

two increments with cumulative effect has been imposed on Malkiat Singh, ASI vide order dated 22.11.2022.

In view of the aforesaid specific response filed by the respondents, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.
