[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 30.05.2019, in CWP No.15511 of 2019 in case titled as Navjot Singh vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.15511 of 2019 was disposed of in limine by directing the official respondents to consider and decide the representation filed by the petitioner by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the directions as contained in order, Annexure P/1 dated 30.05.2019 having been complied with by passing of order dated 13.03.2020 and the petitioner already having challenged the said decision by way of a civil suit, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above, as well

as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
