[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 13.05.2019 in CWP No.524 of 2019 in case titled as Gram Panchayat Shahpur Dogra, Kapurthala vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that order dated 13.05.2019 was passed while staying the operation of the impugned order dated 06.06.2018 which had been passed by the Director, Land Records, Punjab under Section 42 of the East Punjab Holding (Consolidation and Prevention of Fragmentation) Act, 1948 inter alia permitting the partition of the land in dispute amongst the proprietors.

[3] Learned counsel contends that the instant petition was filed on account of respondent No.1 having passed order Annexure P/4 dated 28.11.2019 contrary to order, Annexure P/1 dated 13.05.2019. However, on appeal filed by the petitioner against order, Annexure P/4, order dated 07.10.2020 was passed by the Deputy Director, Consolidation Department, Jalandhar setting aside order, Annexure P/4 dated

28.11.2019 and directing that all partition proceedings would be subject to the outcome of the decision in CWP No.524 of 2019.

[4] Copy of order dated 07.10.2020 has been produced by learned counsel for the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order, Annexure P/4 dated 28.11.2019 having been set aside by the Deputy Director, Consolidation Department, Jalandhar vide order dated 07.10.2020, the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[6] All pending misc. applications also stands disposed of.
