Petitioner is seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 213 dated 24.8.2021, under Sections 379-B(2), 506, 511 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Raj Kumar. The allegations are that on 23.8.2021, three boys tried to enter his house. One of the accused unsuccessfully tried to snatch mobile and other accused gave *dah* blow on the back side of the neck and head of the complainant and his brother respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there was a money dispute between the complainant and co-accused Jagroop Singh. It is a case of false implication. There is no MLR of complainant. No mobile was actually snatched. The petitioners are in custody since 24.8.2021 and investigation is complete.

Learned State counsel opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the petitioners were specifically named in the FIR. The petitioners were identified from the registration number of motor cycle mentioned in the FIR.

He further submits that challan has been presented.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the nature of allegations, more so that no recovery was made from the petitioners, albeit investigation is complete, conclusion of trial is likely to take time and no useful purpose would be served by depriving the personal liberty of the petitioners, bail is granted to the petitioners on furnishing surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
