Vide detailed order dated 04.03.2014, the Company Petition

No.134 of 2012, was admitted and the Official Liquidator attached to this

Court was appointed as the provisional liquidator to take over the movable and immovable assets of the respondent-Company and to proceed in accordance with law. No objection on behalf of the respondent-Company has been received.

The learned counsel representing the Official Liquidator has submitted that despite her best efforts neither the whereabouts of the Directors nor its assets could be traced.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the respondent-Company is ordered to be wound up. The Official Liquidator is directed to take further steps in accordance with law.

Let the notice of order of winding up be published in newspapers namely 'Ajit' (Punjabi), 'Indian Express' (English) and the official Gazette of Government of Punjab.

With all these observations, the Company Petitions are disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
