Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents no.3 and 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from private respondents no.6 and 7.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gunkirat Kaur, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 5.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied, if, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to take a decision on the representation dated 11.1.2022 (Annexure P-3) already submitted by the petitioner expeditiously and in a time bound manner.

I find the prayer to be just and reasonable.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to decide the representation dated 11.1.2022 (Annexure P-3) already submitted by the petitioner within a period of one month from today in accordance with law.
