The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.151 dated 25.08.2021 registered under Sections 21, 25, 27 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985, Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 14.01.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating/Aresting Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 14.01.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
