The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take appropriate action against the private respondent.

Status report by way of affidavit of Gursher Singh, PPS, DSP, Circle Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 had been filed on 05.04.2019. The relevant extract thereof reads as under:-

“3. That the aforesaid application of the petitioner was marked to DSP, Circle Amloh for inquiry. During inquiry of this application, both the parties were joined in inquiry and their statements were recorded. From the inquiry, it was found that the parties have a dispute over 2 Biswas of plot and in this regard, both the parties have filed civil cases in the Hon'ble Courts and both the parties are bound by the verdict to be given by the Hon'ble Civil Courts. Even in their respective statements, both the parties stated that whatever decision will be given by the Civil Court, the same shall be acceptable to them. Therefore, both the parties were suggested

to take-up the matter in the Hon'ble Court and the aforesaid application of the petitioner was recommended to be filed. The true translated copy of said inquiry is hereby enclosed as Annexure R-1/T.”

The aforesaid status report has not been controverted by the petitioner despite lapse of merely three years.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed at this stage.
