SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. In pursuance to the orders, made by this Court, on 11.05.2022, the learned State counsel makes an intimation to this Court, that in respect of the petitioner's grievance appertaining to the concerned, fraudulently withdrawing money from her pension account, and, from her bank account, besides misappropriating it, the petitioner as well as the respondents have recorded a compromise. Therefore, in the wake of the compromise, which has been arrived at in respect of Annexure P-4, this Court does not deem it fit, and, appropriate to direct the Probing Agency concerned, to hereafter draw any coercive action against the accused concerned, nor deems it fit, and, appropriate to direct the Probing Agency to register a FIR in respect of the contents of Annexure P-4.

2. But in case subsequently the settlement is proven to be fake, and, un-authentic, thereupon it is always open to the investigating officer concerned, to draw any appropriate action, in accordance with law, against the offender concerned.
