Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 23.12.2021 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala, whereby revision filed by the petitioner against the order dated 21.06.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Rajpura, in case bearing FIR No.80 dated 17.06.2021, under Section 22 NDPS Act, Police Station Shambhu, dismissing the application for discharge/release of the petitioner from the custody, was dismissed.

Learned State counsel submits that after passing the impugned order, the petitioner stood released on default bail on 23.12.2021, and that if so advised, he can avail the remedy in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Bhagwat Singh Vs. Commissioner of Police 1985 AIR (Supreme Court) 1285.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition, at this stage.
