Prayer in these petitions is for setting aside the impugned order dated 18.11.2019 passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana vide which application dated 30.10.2018 under Section 125 Cr.P.C. for ad-interim maintenance filed by the respondent-wife and minor was allowed.

Both the parties have challenged the above-said order. On interaction with counsel for both the parties, learned Senior counsel has submitted that the parties were referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. With the able assistance of the Mediator, both the

parties have settled the dispute amicably by way of agreement dated 14.11.2022. He has submitted that both the parties are bound by the terms and conditions of the agreement arrived at between them and in pursuance to the same, the parties have agreed to file petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act for dissolving their marriage. He has also submitted that all the issues have been resolved by the parties.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, it is inferred that they desire to withdraw both the petitions in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties before the Mediation Centre.

Accordingly, the parties are allowed to withdraw the above-mentioned petitions on the basis of compromise arrived at between them. Both the parties shall be bound by the terms of agreement/settlement dated 14.11.2022 executed between the parties.
