[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for punishing the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-2) dated 09.11.2021 in CRM-M-46942-2021 in case titled as 'Taranpreet Singh and another versus State of Punjab and others'.

[3] A perusal of order (Annexure P-2) reveals that CRM-M-46942-2021 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 12.10.2021 in accordance with law and to take action if the circumstances of the case so warranted within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[4] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. However, learned Sr. Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has placed on record copy of order dated 01.12.2021 passed by the respondent, deciding the

Sections 323 IPC in FIR No.402 dated 09.10.2021 under Sections 323/324/506/34 and 307 IPC on the representation of the petitioners.

[5] Learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, on instructions from *ASI Tejinder Singh*, further states that decision on the representation of the petitioners was forwarded by the respondent to the Registrar General of Hon'ble the Punjab & Haryana High Court on 21.12.2021. Copy of decision dated 01.12.2021, as well as communication dated 21.12.2021 is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of, as such.

[6] In view of the decision of representation dated 12.10.2021 submitted by the petitioners in terms of order dated 09.11.2021 in CRM-M-46942-2021 vide order dated 01.12.2021 and intimation thereof having been forwarded to the Registrar General of Hon'ble the Punjab & Haryana High Court on 21.12.2021, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent.

[7] Accordingly, the contempt petition is *disposed of*, as such.
