Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.528, dated 08.08.2021, under Sections 148, 149, 186, 323, 332, 353, 379-B, 427 & 506 of IPC (Sections 120-B, 212, 341 added later on), registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order passed by this Court on 03.12.2021 in **CRM-M No.49919 of 2021** - “*Gurjeet alias Sonu @ Gurjit Kumar vs. State of Haryana*” and claims parity.

Learned counsel for the State very fairly submits that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are similar in nature.

Keeping in view the above-said fact, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
