1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-4, dated 10.11.2020, in CWP-18947-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-4 dated 10.11.2020, reveals that CWP-18947-2020, was disposed of by directing the competent authority to decide legal notice dated 08.06.2020, within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has filed reply dated 15.01.2021, to legal notice dated 08.06.2020, informing that the competent authority has no jurisdiction to review its own award, therefore the notice be withdrawn. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof states that he does not press the instant petition but may be granted liberty to take out appropriate proceedings in respect of the refusal of the respondent to grant the relief

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
