Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.41 dated 05.11.2021, under Sections 498-A, 406 of IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Bathinda

By virtue of the order dated 18.01.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
