The present petition has been filed with a prayer that the petitioner, who according to him, has already undergone the sentence awarded to him in an FIR No.164 dated 11.10.2003 registered under Section 302 of the IPC at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana, be released from the prison by issuance of an appropriate direction to respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said request has already been made by the petitioner before the authority concerned by

way of representation dated 10.12.2018 (Annexure P/3) and, though, substantial period has already been elapsed, no order has been passed by the authority concerned on the said request of the petitioner, which fact not only caused prejudice to the petitioner but also forced the petitioner to approach this Court by way of filing the present petition.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, DAG, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the respondents submits that an appropriate order on the representation dated 10.12.2018 (Annexure P/3) submitted by the petitioner will be passed by the competent authority within a period of next four weeks and an outcome of the same will be informed to the petitioner as well.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement given by the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition any further and the same may be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
