Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.175 dated 10.08.2020, registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar (Rural), under Sections 379-B (2) and 411 read with Section 34 IPC.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition. However, he submits that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court within ten days positively and move an appropriate application seeking relief of regular bail there and he further prays that the trial Court be directed to decide the said bail application of the petitioner within some specific time frame.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within ten days from today and moves an application for seeking

the relief of regular bail there, the same shall be decided within one week thereafter.
