Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0269 dated 09.08.2021, under Sections 120-B, 420, 494, 498-A, 506 IPC and Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (Section 420 IPC deleted during investigation) registered at Police Station Hansi Sadar, District Hansi.

By virtue of the order dated 24.01.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 24.01.2022, is made

absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438
(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
