MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.173 dated 13.08.2021 under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 17.01.2022, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel has placed reliance upon the order dated 29.10.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed in CRM-M-45403-2021 in respect of co-accused-Renu Kadiyan, who has been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Notice of motion for 31.01.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-45403-2021.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by SI Suresh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 17.01.2022 is made absolute.
