Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.134 dated 14.05.2021, under Sections 306 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, Tehsil and District Fazilka.

In compliance of order dated 14.01.2022, learned State counsel has placed on record the status report. She has submitted that as per the FSL report, presence of 'Aluminium Phosphide' was confirmed in the viscera.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to surrender before the concerned Court.

Allowed as prayed for.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. In case the petitioner surrenders before the Court of competent jurisdiction within seven days from today and files an application for grant of regular bail, then learned Court is requested to decide his application for bail expeditiously preferably, within three days from the date of filing of the same.
