This is a first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR no.129 dated 13.11.2021 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC at Police Station Fattu Dyinga, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the complainant has pointed out that in spite of last opportunity, the petitioner has not complied with the terms of the order dated 13.05.2022 vide which the interim bail had been granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after seeing that this Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter, in order to avoid an adverse order on merits, seeks to withdraw the present petition.
