SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The learned State counsel submits before this Court, that the petitioner's representation, as embodied in Annexure P-3 has resulted in the registration of FIR against the accused concerned, and, also thereafter, trial has opened against the accused concerned. The above statement has a further legal consequence, that the prayer made in the petition, for directing the respondents concerned, to hold investigations into the complaint concerned, hence becoming rendered infructuous.

2. However, the learned counsel for the petitioner continues to make a submission, that there is yet an imminent endangerment to the life, and, property of the petitioner, as the private respondents are continuing to mete threats to the petitioner. Moreover, in respect of the afore threats a representation was made to the authorities concerned. Consequently, when also at this stage, no credible

evidence has been produced, before this Court, in personification of the gravity of the threats, and, the likelihood of the threats being potentialized. Therefore, the afore relief cannot be granted to the petitioner by this Court. Nonetheless, in the larger interest of justice, the respondent concerned, may in case a fresh representation is made to them with respect to the above, by the petitioner, hence within one week hereafter proceed to decide it through a speaking order, and, preferably within three weeks thereafter.
