Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.144 dated 24.11.2021, under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station PS Women, Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 20.01.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 20.01.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has opposed the prayer made by counsel for the petitioner. He further submits that this Court directed the parties to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, however, the same remained unsuccessful.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 20.01.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
