**Main case**

Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the  
Constitution, *inter alia*, for release of retiral dues of the petitioner.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, states that  
at this stage, instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his client would  
be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 06.11.2021 (P-2) is decided  
expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ayush Sarna, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to the respondents, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 06.11.2021 (P-2), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

It is made clear that in case, there is a failure, the same shall be construed as disobedience of the order of this Court and necessary legal consequences will follow.
