Vide this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.144, dated 29.11.2021, having been registered at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

When this court was not inclined to grant the petitioner the relief sought in view of the fact that there is very little time left between today and marriage and obviously even the factum of the marriage cannot be confirmed by the learned State counsel by then, he does not press this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with learned counsel submitting that he would attend the marriage by video conference as allowed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Patiala, vide her order dated 07.01.2022.
