The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.190 dated 1.7.2020 under Sections 323, 379-B, 427, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

This Court on 14.3.2022 had disposed of the application filed by the petitioner with a direction to the complainant that upon appearing before the learned Area Magistrate, Amritsar within 10 days from today and making a statement before that Court to the effect that he has indeed compromised the matter with the petitioner and has no objection to the petitioner being released on bail, the petitioner would be admitted to bail upon furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of that Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has supplied the

photocopy of the order passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar dated 23.3.2022 whereby the petitioner has now been released on bail. The photocopy of the order is taken on record as Mark X.

In view of the aforesaid position, nothing survives in the present petition and the same has become infructuous.
