The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.121 dated 12.11.2021 registered under Sections 307, 452, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149, 379-B IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

The operative part of the order dated 18.01.2022, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the order dated 21.12.2021 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.53322 of 2021 and submits that though, the allegations are that he has caused grievous injury, however, he is ready to compensate the victim by paying Rs.1,00,000/- towards the medical expenses, without prejudice to his right of defence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 18.01.2022, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation. It is further submitted that in compliance with aforesaid order, a demand draft of Rs. 1.00 lac has already been handed over to the victim.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Mohinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 18.01.2022, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
