Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.487, dated 25.06.2021, under Sections 406, 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 419, 120-B of IPC, 1860 and Sections 7, 13(1)(d) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order passed by this Court on 09.12.2021 in **CRM-M No.39998 of 2021** - "***Varun Dev Garg vs. State of Haryana***", whereby co-accused has been granted the concession of regular bail.

Learned counsel for the State very fairly submits that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are similar in nature.

Keeping in view the nature of the allegations levelled against all the accused, this Court finds that the accused-petitioner deserves parity and is thus, entitled for grant of regular bail. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Nothing observed herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion of the merits of the case.
