Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0120 dated 21.07.2021 under Section 306 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur, who apprehends her arrest at the hands of Police.

On 19.01.2022, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon the order dated 28.12.2021 (Annexure P-4) passed by this Court in CRM-M-54565-2021.

Notice of motion for 04.03.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-54565-2021.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in

compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated herself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by SI Maninder Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 19.01.2022 is made absolute.
