Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No.65 dated 05.9.2021, under Section 22-C of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran.

As per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner was apprehended and 2250 intoxicant tablets brand Tramadol (Corlividoll-100 SR) were recovered from him.

Mr. Mann, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab states that the intoxicant tablets recovered from the petitioner was sent to the FSL. As per the FSL report, the salt from the intoxicant tablets was detected to be

as diclofenac sodium, which is not psychotropic substance.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
