The petitioners claim to have married on 12.01.2022, against the wishes of the parents of petitioner no.1. They seek protection to their life and liberty from respondent No. 4 to 8.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Monika Jalota, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1 to 3.

Mr. Sarfraz Anjum Mor, Advocate, enters appearance on behalf of respondent no.4 to 8 and submits that the respondent no.4 to 8 have no objection if petitioner no.1 wishes to reside with petitioner no.2. However, he submits that the wishes of petitioner no.1 are required to be ascertained.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, is requested to record the statement of petitioner no.1 in the presence of the private respondents. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, is also requested to take suitable measures in order to

protect the life and liberty of the young couple, if need be.
