Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.100 dated 23.11.2020, under Sections 376, 506 and 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Women Police Station Rewari

By virtue of the order dated 01.12.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
