[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 09.06.2014, in CWP No.5256 of 2013 in case titled as 'Karandeep Singh KaironversusState of Punjab and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.5256 of 2013 was disposed of with a direction to the respondent to issue five days notice to the petitioner, in case, the security/protection provided to him was sought to be withdrawn by the respondents.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that security/protection provided to the petitioner has been restored, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
