An application filed by the petitioner during the pendency of the suit with a prayer for his impleadment as a defendant has been dismissed by the trial court

The dispute is with regard to the property left behind by late Sh. Salig Ram, who is stated to have been died issueless. The suit has been filed by his brother Sh. Tek Chand Punjani. The children and the grand children of the another brother of late Sh. Salig Ram are already contesting the suit. In fact, on the death of Sh. Salig Ram, his property was inherited by his widow being Class-I heir. She during her life time transferred the property in favour of her husband's brother Sh. Jaswant Ram, who has bequeathed the property in favour of his children and grand children. The applicant claims to be Sh. Saligram's sister's son. The trial court on examination of the facts has found that the applicant is not a necessary party.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner though made a sincere attempt, however, failed to convince the court as to how the applicant (the petitioner) is necessary party in a suit which is pending between Sh. Tek Chand Punjani and heirs of Sh. Jaswant Ram.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
