The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 1030 dated 12.10.2018, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 201 IPC at Police Station Central Faridabad.

The FIR in this case was registered on the basis of the complaint lodged by complainant Islamuddin being attorney of Pushpa Devi widow of Kishan Lal, Prince Kumar and Hira Lal sons of Kishan Chand residents of Charkhi Dadri, Haryana. In the said complaint it was alleged that Kishan Chand purchased land measuring 11 kanals 18 marlas being 1/12th share of total land measuring 140 kanals and 19 marlas vide sale deed dated 28.05.1957. Mohan Lal and Kamlesh Kumar who allegedly proclaimed themselves to be the owner of the said land, sold the same to Satya Parkash Tyagi vide sale deed dated 02.12.2010 and petitioner and C.S. Sharma, Advocate signed the said sale deed as

attesting witnesses. The aforesaid sale-deed was executed fraudulently by Mohan Lal and Kamlesh Kumar without having any right to sell the said property.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in the light of the previous order of interim bail dated 18.01.2022 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

The State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar has not refuted this fact and further submits that now the petitioner is not required by police for any further investigation.

In view of the above, instant petition is allowed. Order dated 18.01.2022 granting ad interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
