Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.22, dated 11.01.2021, registered under Sections 406, 420 of IPC and Sections 66, 66-C and 66-D of Information Technology Act, at Police Station Civil Line, Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been implicated in the present case only on the basis of the disclosure statement made by co-accused Naseem, who is the main accused. He further states that the recovery has also been made from the account of Naseem only.

Learned counsel for the State has not controverted the said fact.

Keeping in view the facts that the investigation is already complete, challan stands presented and the material recovery is alleged to have been made from the main accused, Naseem, this Court finds that the petitioner is held entitled for grant of regular bail. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Nothing observed herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
