Main Case

This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the
Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of

directions to respondents to release petitioner for four weeks parole to

perform marriage ceremonies of his nephew (sister's son) Brahminder Singh, which is scheduled for 04.02.2022, in accordance with his entitlement as envisaged under Section 3(1)(b) of Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 07.01.2022 to respondent No.3-Superintendent, Central Jail, Patiala, District Patiala, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Arun Kaundal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent, Central Jail, Patiala, District Patiala, to look into and decide representation dated 07.01.2022 (Annexure P/1) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within three days positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
